SAFETY NOTES

Parents / Guardians;

It is the intent of the PHL to offer a fun and safe environment for all players and spectators to enjoy. Please review the safety guidelines below with your players to ensure they understand and comply accordingly.

Equipment

- Players **must** wear full equipment for all on court practices and games.
- Mouth guards **must** be in the players mouth while on the court, it can be removed while on the bench
- Players **must** wear their helmet at all times while on the bench, the face mask can be moved to obtain a drink of water.
- Equipment is to be securely stored and out of normal foot paths while not in use.

Skating

- Is **not** permitted in the bleachers, players are to put on / take off skates at the floor level.
- Is **not** permitted outside the glass doors to the court area other than for a direct visit to the washroom.
- Skating and the use of sticks, pucks, or balls in the area between the bleachers or between the boards and bleachers are **not** permitted other than to prepare for or exit from the court.

Spectators

- Are **not** permitted to stand adjacent the safety netting above the court boards.
- Are **not** permitted on the court during PHL events unless specifically requested by a PHL official.
- Are encouraged to watch the play on the court at all times as the puck may leave the court unexpectedly.
- Waste bins are located throughout the facility, please dispose of your own garbage

It is the parent / guardian's responsibility to ensure your players are conducting themselves in a reasonable and safe manner while attending PHL events. Players who do not comply with the above guidelines will be warned, penalized, suspended, or disciplined as deemed necessary by the PHL.
